



Catch The Ace

Progressive Raffle Lottery

Rules and Regulations

- Must be at least 18 years of age to play
- Tickets are \$5 each and may be purchased every week beginning Tuesday
- Tickets will be available through any member of SCGM LC
- All ticket sales cease at 6:00 p.m. on the following Monday
- One deck of 52 cards will be placed and sealed in brown envelopes, then randomly numbered from 1 to 52, placed in a locked glass-fronted case which will be on display during the raffle drawings
- Only 500 tickets will be available for purchase for the first 10 weeks; then followed by 600 tickets for 25 weeks for a total time of 35 weeks. The draws will conclude once the Ace of Spades is found.
- **PURCHASER MUST** – Complete the ticket stub, including name and phone number, and enter a valid envelope number from the list of available numbers on display on the club website (scgmlions.org)
- The ticket purchaser will be responsible for ensuring their ticket is filled out completely
- Tickets are only valid for the weekly draw for which they were purchased
- Ticket sales will be limited to three (3) tickets or less per person at the discretion of the CTA Raffle Committee.
- Members of Scarborough Cedarbrae Golden Mile Lions club are ineligible to win any prizes in this raffle.

Draw Time and Location

- Draws will be conducted on Mondays at 7 p.m. at Agincourt Recreation Centre, 31 Glen Watford Drive, Scarborough, Ontario.

- Only one (1) ticket will be drawn each week. See Draw Rules for Week 35 for special rules during that draw.
- The purchaser of the ticket drawn does not need to be in attendance to win.
- All draws will be video recorded live and published on Scarborough Cedarbrae Golden Mile Lions Club website and/or social media and will show the name on the winning ticket, the envelope selected on that ticket, and the card contained in the identified envelope.

Draw Rules

- Weekly draw prize and Progressive Jackpot amounts will be announced prior to each draw
- At 7 p.m., one (1) ticket stub will be randomly drawn from all tickets sold that week. The winning ticket holder will receive the weekly prize amounting to 20% of that week's ticket sales. The envelope number shown on the ticket will be opened.
- If the ticket drawn does not have an envelope number or has an invalid number, the CTA Raffle Committee will make one (1) attempt to contact the ticket holder at the phone number shown on the ticket. This person will be asked to select a number from the remaining envelopes and that card will be revealed.
- If unsuccessful in making contact, the CTA Raffle Committee will select the lowest remaining envelope number.
- If the selected envelope does not contain the **Ace of Spades**, the card will be destroyed and that envelope number will be removed from the following week's envelope selection. 30% of tickets sales from the draw each week will be rolled over to the Progressive Jackpot.
- If the selected envelope contains the **Ace of Spades**, the winner will also be awarded the **Progressive Jackpot**.
 - This will conclude the series of draws for this raffle; a new raffle will begin at an advertised date.
- The winning ticket holder will be notified by phone and advised when they can claim their prize at Agincourt Recreation Centre, 31 Glen Watford Drive, Scarborough, Ontario. A photo ID will be required to claim any prize. All prizes awarded will be paid by cheque to the person named on the winning ticket.

Draw Rules – Week 35 Only

- If after 34 weeks the **Ace of Spades** has not been revealed, the Progressive Jackpot will be awarded on the 35th week of the raffle. The draw will be held at the regular time at

the designated location. The first ticket drawn on Week 35 will receive the weekly prize amounting to 20% of that week's ticket sales. The envelope number shown on the ticket will be opened to reveal the card inside.

- If the card is not the **Ace of Spades**, another ticket will be drawn. This and all subsequent tickets drawn after the first ticket will not win the weekly prize, but the envelope number shown on the ticket will be eligible for the Progressive Jackpot.
 - If the ticket drawn does not have an envelope number or has an invalid number, the CTA Raffle Committee will make one (1) attempt to contact the ticket holder at the phone number shown on the ticket. This person will be asked to select a number from the remaining envelopes and that card will be revealed. If this person is present at the drawing, they will be asked to select a number from the remaining envelopes, and that card will be revealed.
 - If unsuccessful in making contact, the CTA Raffle Committee will select the lowest remaining envelope number.
 - The ticket holder that reveals the Ace of Spades will be declared the **Jackpot Winner**.
